Amendments to bookings may be made up to 7 days prior to the date of the course.

Cancellation If you find you are unable to attend a course less than 7 days before the date of the course you are welcome to send someone else in your place. We regret that the course fees will only be refunded if we are able to fill your place. If you fail to attend a course without giving the required notice, we reserve the right not to refund your payment. In the unlikely event we have to cancel a course, we will endeavour to provide a suitable alternative within a reasonable period of time. If this is not possible you will be entitled to a full refund.
